Dear Parents/Guardians:


On Thursday, 10 May, St. Paul's High School students are invited to participate in a prayer service at St. Mary's Cathedral in solidarity with the Catholic Church in perceiving the sacredness in every human life from conception to natural death. The prayer service will be led by Archbishop Richard Gagnon and Archbishop Albert LeGatt as a collaborative effort of the Archdioceses of Winnipeg and St. Boniface.

Participants will attend their period one classes and then be transported by bus to St. Mary's Cathedral for the prayer service which begins at 10:30AM. Following the prayer service, students will be bussed back to St. Paul's High School with an approximate arrival time of 12:20PM. Students will be given time to eat lunch and then attend their afternoon classes. St. Paul's faculty members will accompany and supervise students throughout the duration of the prayer service and on the buses to and from St. Paul's High School. Some students may wish to participate in the March for Life following the prayer service. A separate permission form is included for this activity as it will not be a school-supervised event.


Students will be responsible for properly notifying their teachers and making up any work they will miss. By participating, there are no anticipated risks to your son other than the risks of daily life. If you permit your son to participate in the prayer service please complete the form on the next page and return it to Ms. Caron. You may also complete the second form if you permit your son to participate in the March for Life procession.

If numbers become an issue, participants will be chosen based on the order in which their permission forms were received and the number of available spaces on the buses. Permission forms must be submitted no later than 9:00AM on Monday, 7 May in order to confirm requirements for bus transportation. An information meeting will be held for all participants prior to the event.
